SIX AWARD CATEGORIES:

BUILDINGS – LARGE PROJECTS

(over \$5,000,000) for application component

BUILDINGS – SMALL PROJECTS

(up to \$5,000,000) for application component

AUSTRALIAN STEEL-CLAD STRUCTURES

(Warehouses, Industrial Building, Façades, etc)

INNOVATIVE COLD FORM STEEL BUILDING

(Excludes Class 1 Buildings and Industrial, Warehouse and Sheds)

ENGINEERING PROJECTS

(Infrastructure, Resources and Mining)

YOUNG DESIGNER/DETAILER/TRADES PERSON

Categories 1-5 must have been fabricated in Australia from predominantly Australian made steel to qualify.

The application fee of \$450 is payable at the point of submitting your entry. All costs associated with your entry's documentation, presentations or videos are the responsibility of the nominee.
